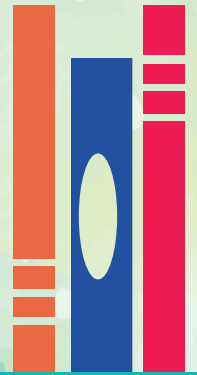




INDIVIDUALIZED Reading INSTRUCTION



Hear Indiana is excited to provide reading evaluations and individualized instruction to children with hearing loss in Pre-K-12th grade!

Often, children with hearing loss need explicit instruction to help develop and maintain the decoding and comprehension skills they need to be successful in the classroom and meet their reading potential.



Our evaluation process uses standardized assessments to identify each student's strengths and weaknesses and target the areas that will help them meet their reading potential.

Individualized instruction uses research validated sensory-cognitive instruction techniques in a one-on-one setting to help students develop their language and literacy skills.



Sessions are 30-60 minutes long and include consultation, home practice, monthly reports, and communication and phone consultation with schools and/or teachers. Evaluations include consultation and goal recommendations to parents and school districts. Cost is based on a sliding scale, which takes income and household size into account.
